

Bargaining Committee - Update #5

On June 5, 6, 12 and 13, your Bargaining Committee continued negotiations with NAIT and the discussions were centered around NASA members' number one priority, workload. The Bargaining Committee brought forward issues and concerns relating to transparency, flexibility and equity. Discussions also focused on the roles and responsibilities of an instructor.

Workload discussions have been difficult and complex but our side remains steadfast on reaching an agreement in principle. The next round of negotiations is scheduled for June 26 and 27. These discussions will continue to be focused on workload. The Bargaining Committee remains committed to achieving agreement with NAIT on a workload model that is clear, understandable and reasonable.

With agreement not being reached on a workload model, and a number of priorities still to discuss, NASA anticipates collective bargaining to continue over into the fall months. No new bargaining dates have been decided upon and we will communicate this information after our next round of negotiations on June 27.
